EALING COUNCIL in conjunction with the METROPOLITAN POLICE are running an initiative called MET TRACE whereby HIGH RISK AREA's are visited by officers on MET TRACE and

residents are offered to be SMARTWATER registered.

WHAT IS SMARTWATER?

This is a liquid substance that has a UNIQUE DNA coding, when it is swabbed onto a valued item of your property it dries with the DNA Coding to give your property an identity linking it with its owners, SMARTWATER is said to remain on that item for at least 5 years +, including jewellery, rings etc.

A form is completed with the DNA code which is put on file; the police should also have this information on file.

If your residence is then targeted and your valued property is taken, there is a greater chance of suspects being identified and your property being identified for recovery with the use of SMARTWATER.

I was informed that SOUTHFIELD WARD is **NOT** high risk area, but talks with EALING COUNCIL has released SMARTWATER, for me to disseminate on the ward.

I feel that this is an invaluable tool against potential burglaries and especially before the Christmas period I would like for more homes to have this PROTECTION.

I would like to compile a list of residents whom would be interested in SMARTWATER, so I can put this list of amounts to the council for them to release supplies of SMARTWATER.
